The organization:

The National Council of Women of Republic of Macedonia – UWOM is a national, multi-ethnic and multi-generational network, creatively oriented towards the future. It has been active more than a whole decade. It was founded in October 1994, and since then it grew into one of the biggest women’s networks in Republic of Macedonia.

The NCWM – UWOM networks 104 independent women’s organizations throughout Republic of Macedonia. Members of those organizations are women of all age groups, various by social, educational level, ethnic origin and belonging to all religions. They have different interests of acting, but they all share the NCWM – UWOM’s mission and work towards its fulfillment.

The project:

“There are 1325 reasons for implementation of 1325 Resolution” aims to incorporate a gender perspective in the peace and security policy of Republic of Macedonia.

The project consists of the realization of 12 trainings of two sessions each time on different cities around the country. The content of the trainings are mainly: Presentation on the Resolution 1325 and the role of women in the prevention and resolution of conflicts and in peace-building, International and National instruments and mechanism for the implementation of the resolution. Gender perspective in the decision making structures in the Republic of Macedonia, Gender based violence and Gender stereotypes.

The trainings are addressed to the Women’s NGOs from Republic of Macedonia (that are working on peace activities), Representatives from Ministry of defense, Ministry of external affairs, Ministry of internal affairs, Ministry of justice, Women’s Parliamentary Club, Military Academy, Police Academy, Macedonian Army, Public prosecution, Centre for crisis management), Representatives from local communities and gender commissions
